- Sign a Membership Agreement with the Mid Carolina Forest Management Group Certification Program.
- Submit proof of ownership or lease rights for the properties in question.
- Receive a site assessment visit from a Mid Carolina Forest Management Group representative.

By signing this application for membership in the Mid Carolina Forest Management Group Certification Program, you acknowledge and understand that to be certified you must follow all requirements as detailed in the Mid Carolina Forest Management Group Operations Manual. You must also agree to allow Mid Carolina Forest Management Group, Bureau Veritas and FSC access to your land, following appropriate notification, for the purpose of monitoring compliance with the criteria of the Forest Stewardship Council and the Mid Carolina Forest Management Group Certification Program.

Membership is voluntary, and you are free to end your membership with a 30 day notification, but you may not be eligible to rejoin at a later date and any membership fees will not be reimbursed.
